

TMGC Local Rules:

Hole #8

Lake on **Hole #8** is marked with yellow stakes. Drop zone available on tee side of lake near the forward tees. This local rule is effect on Hole # 8; **Water Hazards; Ball Played Provisionally Under Rule 26-1**. If there is doubt whether a ball is in or is lost in the water hazard on hole # 8, the player may play another ball provisionally under any of the applicable options in Rule 26-1. If the original ball is found outside the water hazard, the player must continue play with it. If the original ball is found in the water hazard, the player may either play the original ball as it lies or continue with the ball played provisionally under rule 26-1. If the original ball is not found or identified within the five-minute search period, the player must continue with the ball played provisionally.

Hole #9

Left of the cart path between Hole #9 and the practice green is OB, the edge of the cart path between the hole and the practice green defines the boundary.

Hole #10

Left of cart path on Hole #10 is OB.

Hole #11

White stakes on Hole #11 define OB.

Hole #12

Play is prohibited left of the lake on Hole #12. Balls hit in the lake left of the fairway on Hole #12 may use the red tee box as an optional drop area.

Hole #18

Balls entering the lake hazard on Hole #18 to the right of the Pole must be re-teed or dropped at the front of the tee box. Balls entering the lake to the left of the Pole may move to the drop area next to Charlie Austin Pole by the bridge.

All cart and maintenance paths will be played as obstructions, including coble stones placed to extend the maintenance paths coverage and including the path to the south of the ninth fairway. Please remember to play a provisional ball when hitting into the high, native grass outside of hazards...**AND AS ALWAYS WATCH OUT** for rattlesnakes.
